October - December :

Conduct a flag design competition at your school and determine a winner.

Theme: *Art Shapes the World* - YAM logo must be included in the design

Size: The overall winning images will be enlarged to a 3' x 5' flag, please scale accordingly or use the template provided.

- "What Art Means to Me" (included)
- Photo Release Form (included)
- **Deadline: BEFORE Wednesday, January 11th!**

If your students image is the OVERALL winner A FLAG WILL BE SENT DIRECTLY TO YOU FOR DESIGN TRANSFER., giving you approximately 3 weeks to complete the design transfer and return to your YAM Co-Chairs by February 1st.
